Reason 1



Local councils give ENABLE Scotland money to support people

Reason 2

ENABLE Scotland makes money through fundraising.



Last year it was difficult to make money through fundraising.

But we managed to raise more money through fundraising than we did the year before.



We did this by

- People raising money for ENABLE Scotland
- Holding events where people give us money
- People leaving money to ENABLE Scotland when they die
- Getting money from places like the Big Lottery Fund



Reason 3

ENABLE Scotland has been better at reducing the amount of money it spends.



Last year we had to pay the Government a big tax bill.

We did not need to pay that bill again this year



This year we have been careful to spend money where we need to.

We did this by concentrating on our:

- Cash
- Customers
- Co-workers
