Reason 1

Reason 2

ENABLE Scotland makes money through fundraising.



Last year it was still difficult to make money through fundraising.

- People leaving money to ENABLE Scotland when they die.
- Getting money from places like the Big Lottery Fund.
- Raising money through company partnerships.
